Grafton-On-Sea was a quiet fishing village until the Victorians built the pier railway station for passengers on the pleasure steamers. Set in the 1960's the trains bring in day trippers, the tramways provide local transport and the fun fair gives amusement for children of all ages. The layout was conceived to inspire the Junior members who have been involved in various aspects of the layout but it outgrew their skills..

- Dimensions:** 8ft x 2ft 6in. (2.3m * 0.75m), A 2ft passage to the rear is useful for access.
Tables: Free-standing with viewing to two sides. The pier is the prominent corner.
A small table is useful for rolling stock.
Power: Single 13Amp socket.
Operators: Up to 2 juniors and two supervisors.
Transport: One estate car load, or two hatchbacks.
Expenses: Fuel for the vehicle and refreshments for the operators.
Set-up time: half hour
Insurance: Value of layout and stock £1000.
